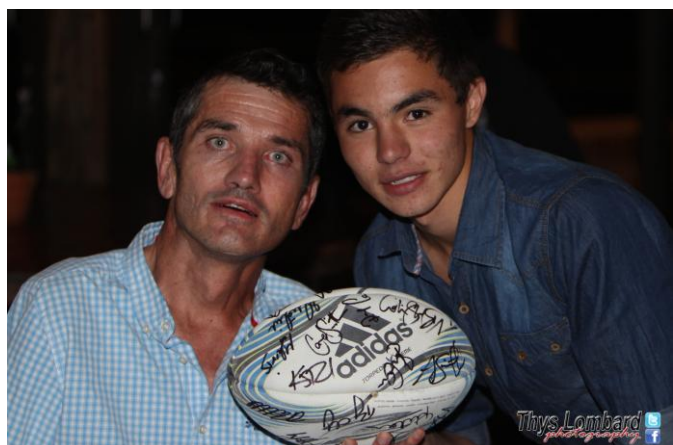
JOOST VAN DER WESTHUIZEN AT BOESMANLAND
